Early review allows new students to make arrangements regarding work or relocation. CHANGE IN MINIMUM TOEFL IBT SCORE Effective Fall 2015, international students will need to score a minimum of 80 (change from 61) on the TOEFL IBT to be eligible for admission to the doctoral program in Curriculum and Instruction. Rationale: The higher score is more consistent with the demands of writing a dissertation in English. Other doctoral programs in the college (e.g. Counseling; Exceptional Student Education) also require a score of 79-80.
