

Procedure for Graduate Level Certificate Programs
Draft Policy for Review at the August 14, 2019 UGC/UGPC Meeting

A list of all graduate level certificate programs offered by Florida Atlantic University is available in the Degree Programs chapter of the [University Course Catalog](#), under the heading *Graduate Certificate Programs*. Program descriptions, requirements, and admissions criteria are listed in specific college sections of the University Course Catalog. Graduate Certificate programs provide a multidisciplinary perspective and are available to all graduate students, unless stated otherwise in the program descriptions. The completion of these programs are noted on the student's official university transcript, if the following conditions are met:

- 1. The student must apply and be admitted into the graduate certificate program in order to be officially recognized as pursuing the program by the university.**
 - Some certificate programs may be restricted by program or offered only to degree-seeking students, while others are open to all enrolled graduate and post-baccalaureate non-degree students.
 - Students who wish to pursue a graduate certificate that does not require concurrent enrollment in a degree program, must submit a non-degree application to enroll in certificate courses. Subsequent formal admission to the certificate program would be required and the student should reach out to the department early in the enrollment process.
 - Formal admission criteria and admissions procedures are listed in specific college sections of the course catalog. Students should contact the department offering the certificate program for information.
 - Departments may contact the Graduate College for assistance with admissions criteria, procedures, or the development of an online application.

- 2. The student must apply to the graduate certificate program prior to completing the second course in the program.**
 - Completing the certification program coursework without proper admission to the program could jeopardize future enrollment opportunities in certificate program courses or the recognition of the completion of the certificate program by the university.
 - Once the department admits the student to the certificate program, the department will notify the Graduate College, via the [Form 16](#) process, so the student's official academic record can be updated.

- 3. The student must apply for graduate certificate conferral.**
 - In the student's last term of enrollment in a course applicable to the certificate, the student will follow the department procedure to submit an [Application for Certificate \(AFC\)](#) to the Graduate College.
 - After review, the Graduate College will submit the AFC to the Office of the Registrar and the certificate will be posted to the student's official transcript.
 - Students should refer to the [Academic Calendar](#) for AFC submission and deadline dates for each semester (please reference the "Last Day to Submit Application for Degree" date).

In the event that the student completes a degree program prior to completing the requirements for the certificate, the student would be required to be readmitted as a degree seeking or non-degree seeking student to complete the certificate program.

Students completing an undergraduate degree may not enter a graduate certificate program unless they are also admitted as a degree-seeking graduate student or post-baccalaureate non-degree student.
