Please explain the requested change(s) and offer rationale below or on an attachment The Ph.D. program in Experimental Psychology currently requires 90 credits, including 10 credits of quantitative coursework, 15 credits in the major area (Cognitive, Developmental, Social/Personality, or Behavioral Neuroscience), 18 elective credits outside the major area, 6 Masters thesis credits, 9 Ph.D. dissertation credits, and 32 elective credits from the areas listed above, Dissertation (PSY 7980), Advanced Research in Psychology (PSY 7978) or Directed Independent Study (EP 6908). We propose reducing the number of elective credits from outside the major area from 18 to 9, bringing the total number of credits to 81. This total is consistent with the number of credits required by other departments in the College of Science as well as other psychology programs in the SUS (e.g., FIU and UCF, both require 75 credits).
