- TOEFL score of 500 or IBT of 61; IELTS 6.0; Duolingo 90
- Evidence of Professional Certification or eligibility for temporary certificate
- Two (2) letters of recommendation that highlight the candidate's academic potential from a previous professor, employer, or colleague (optional, at the discretion of each program)
