New course request

We would like to request the addition of **EDA 6053 Contemporary Trends in Education** to the program requirements and catalog (New Course Form and Syllabus attached)

Rationale: This course has been created to provide a deeper dive into six important topics covered in both master's and specialist programs. The topics are fiscal management practices, school culture

and safety, needs of varied student populations, curriculum leadership, human capital leadership and management, and contemporary trends in education law.

Program changes

These changes will affect both Master's and Education Specialist Degrees (see MED and EDS Change Program Requests and Professional Knowledge Program Requirements attached).

Additionally, we would like to request the removal of:

EDF 6786 Policy and Politics. To be removed from the program requirements and FAU catalog for the reasons mentioned above.

EDA 6191 Leadership for Social Justice is a course that is listed in the FAU catalog. While we are removing the course as a program requirement we are recommending that this course remain in the catalog for possible use as an elective.
