Masters of Education in Elementary Education

Proposed changes and rationale

The faculty of the department of Curriculum and Instruction request to modify the course options within the Masters in Elementary Education program to update the program. The first change is to remove courses that are no longer regularly offered in the course schedule (LAE 6352, LAE 6415, HSC 5315, RED 6518) and, after consultation with affected departments, are not the best fit for our program students (EDA 6232, EDS 6050, EEX 5015). The second change is to remove the subcategories of "Educational Leadership" and "Special Education" from the program and, in consultation with those departments, list one course most appropriate for the program in the "Elementary Education" course list.

As a result of removing the two subcategories, we will expand the credits in the "Elementary Education" category to 18 and the "Elective" category to 12. By expanding the "Elective" category to 12, we allow our students to explore and include various certificate programs offered by the College. Additional courses will be added to the "Elementary Education" list to reflect updated needs for educators in the field of elementary education (EEX 5051, EDF 6432, EDF 6800,)

CATALOG CHANGES

Elementary Education Master of Education (M.Ed.)

The Department of Curriculum and Instruction offers a program of study leading to a master's degree in Elementary Education. This program is directed toward currently (K-6) certified and experienced teachers who are pursuing an advanced degree.

Admission Requirements

To be admitted to the M.Ed. in Elementary Education Program, students must complete the graduate application and provide documentation showing that they:

- 1. Have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university;
- 2. Have an undergraduate cumulative GPA of 3.0;
- 3. Personal statement;
- 4. Résumé;
- 5. Two letters of recommendation that highlight the candidate's academic potential from a previous professor, employer or colleague (optional), at the discretion of each program)
