




<p>Please explain the requested change(s) and offer rationale below or on an attachment.</p> <p>Drop ACG6135 Advanced Accounting Theory from the Foundation Courses for the Ph.D. in Business Administration with concentration in Accounting program due to the decreased relevance of the course and the inability of the students to fit it in their first semester schedules (when the course is most relevant), except for an additional fee. Previously, students were taking four graduate level courses (12 credits) including ACG6135 but the College provides tuition waiver for 10 credits only, resulting in additional tuition fees to be paid by students, which caused some of them financial difficulties.</p>
