Admission Requirements (Changes effective fall 2025.)

The highlighted text has been previously approved during 2024-2025.

- 1. The student must have a master's degree from an approved college or university.
- 2. The student must have a grade point average and Graduate Record Examination scores as follows:
 - a. An average of 3.0 3.5 or higher in all graduate work taken; and
 - b. Undergraduate GPA of 3.0 in the last 60 credits.
 - c. Minimum GRE scores of 148 (verbal), 144 (quantitative) and 3 (analytical writing).
- 3. The student must have completed at least two three years of full-time experience working with/supporting individuals with disabilities.
- 4. The student must submit a personal statement describing research/scholarly and academic interests, strengths, areas of growth and the names of two potential faculty members to serve as major professor(s).
- 5. Each applicant for admission to the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degree in Special Education must be approved for admission by the department. This recommendation will in part be based upon an interview and a writing sample.
- 6. Application materials must be received no later than February 1 for fall admission.
