The Master of Education (M.Ed.) with major in Counselor Education may be structured with a Clinical Mental Health Counseling, Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling or School Counseling concentration. Note that admission requirements differ for these concentrations. The concentrations in Clinical Mental Health Counseling and School Counseling require 60 credits; the concentration in Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling requires 63 credits. **The School Counseling concentration is available in person or online.**
