RATIONALE FOR CHANGES

The new name of the concentration, **Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education**, reflects the interdisciplinary content of the proposed change, which integrates the disciplines of early childhood education, early intervention, early childhood special education, and environmental education.

New courses in *Early Childhood Environmental Education* are added as electives to offer current perspectives, foundational theories, and epistemologies related to supporting child and nature interactions focused on the well-being of both children/humans and species (more than human world). These courses represent new content and is in keeping with calls from various fields and professional organizations.

The **structure of the concentration** is changed to facilitate timely matriculation of students by offering at least two courses every semester (including summer) and to offer greater flexibility in learning choices based on student interest and learning needs.
