## Memo on Summer Paper Course for COB EPhD Program

Students in the College of Business PhD Program (Executive concentration) currently complete a replication project during their first summer in the program. For this project, students register for 3 credits of Advance Research (7978). We also use this course when students are working on their dissertation proposal and have not been approved for candidacy.

This set up can be confusing to students and makes it difficult for faculty / advisors to monitor their progress toward degree. We would therefore like to create a new course (MAN 7918, Summer Paper) for the replication project and make the corresponding changes necessary in the program description in the catalog.

Since this course consists of independent study by the student in completing the replication under the supervision of a faculty member, a syllabus is not required.
