Please explain the requested change(s) and offer rationale below or on an attachment The Department of Special Education (DSE) proposes to change the admission criteria and application deadlines for the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) program. The department seeks to change the admission criteria to expand accessibility to the program. The changes include the elimination of the GRE, lowering the undergraduate GPA (using the last 60 credit hours), lowering the graduate GPA, and adding a personal statement. Each change is expected to encourage students to apply to the program, mainly working professionals who may desire a doctoral degree but have been discouraged by the previous admission criteria. The admission deadline will also change. Moving the deadline to February will allow the faculty admission committee to make decisions early, thereby allowing students to decide about accepting the admission offer earlier. If the department is to attract the most qualified students, it is necessary to make admission decisions early to ensure funding and other support are available. - 2. The student must have a grade point average and Graduate Record

 Examination scores as follows:
 - a. An average of 3.0 3.5 or higher in all graduate work taken;
 - b. Undergraduate GPA of 3.0 in the last 60 credit hours
 - c. Minimum GRE scores of 148 (verbal), 144 (quantitative) and 3 (analytical writing).
- 3. The student must have completed at least two three years of full-time experience working with/supporting individuals with disabilities.
- 4. The student must submit a personal statement describing research/scholarly and academic interests, strengths, areas of growth, and two potential faculty members to serve as major professor.
- 5. Each applicant for admission to the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degree in Special Education must be approved for admission by the department. This recommendation will in part be based upon an interview and a writing sample.
