At the August 19, 2020, University Graduate Council meeting, the UGC decided to place the following items of curriculum on the Action Agenda:

1. Minor in Artificial Intelligence. It was placed on the Action Agenda because there are so few minors in the Graduate programs, and because the pool of students that would be drawn to this program would come from outside the College of Engineering and Computer Science, which might warrant discussion. This is a new program, with existing coursework, and it was approved with a positive recommendation.
