In addition to program directors increasing their awareness of the students' progress, Dean Stackman and Registrar, Marie Claire Demassi, are developing a report that will generate a list of all students that have fallen below the minimum GPA. This report will be forwarded to program directors and advisors notifying them of the progress of the students in their programs. Students that fall below the minimum GPA will work with their advisors and program directors on an academic Progression Plan to get them back on track.
