1. To make room for the course, we are reducing the hours for the Advanced Research courses from 9 to 6.

2. We wish to include ACG 7918 Seminar in Current Accounting Research Issues as an alternative course for ACG 7837, Survey of Accounting Behavioral Research under executive courses. The reason for this change is to provide the School of Accounting flexibility based on student interests.
