The program requires 156 credits of which 120 are for the Bachelors degree and 36 credits are for the M.A. degree. Students apply to the program in the second semester of their Junior year or upon completion of 60 credits in a Bachelors program at FAU. Once admitted, students may take up to 12 credits of graduate course work in their Senior year, which may be used to satisfy the requirements of both the undergraduate and graduate degrees.
