## Artemia Decapsulation

- 1. Soak 1 can of cysts in freshwater for 1 1.5 hours.
- 2. Drain cysts and place into a hatching cone.
- 3. Add 2 L of chilled seawater to the hatching cone.
- 4. Add a vigorous amount of air to the hatching cone.
- 5. Add 20 g of NaOH to the hatching cone.
- 6. Add 2 L of chilled liquid chlorine to the hatching cone.
- 7. Wait 2-5 minutes for decapsulation to occur. The cysts will turn from a dark brown color to an orange color.
- 8. Add 60 g of sodium thiosulfate to the hatching cone.
- 9. Drain the cysts into a fine mesh filter.
- 10. Rinse cysts with freshwater until no chlorine remains.
- 11.Add the cysts to a container.
- 12. Fill the container with a hypersaline solution.
- 13. Store container in the refrigerator. Decapsulated cysts should remain viable for a few months.
