General Requirements

(Prerequisites vary depending on the individual university)

- Biology- 1 year with lab
- Chemistry: 2 years with lab
 - Including 1 year of organic chemistry
- Physics: 1 year
- Biochemistry- 1 semester
- Mathematics- 1 year
 - Calculus recommended
- English- 1 year
- Behavioral Sciences- 1 year/2 semesters
 - Humanities, Psychology, Sociology, Bioethics, etc.

Additional Requirements

- MCAT
 - Taken no later than September of the year preceding application

- Shadowing Hours
- Interviews
- Volunteering at Hospital
- Extracurricular activities
- Work experiences in medical field
- Strong letters of Recommendations

- FAU
 - Average MCAT
 - 31
 - GPA
 - 3.7
 - 64 Slots, about 4,000 applicants
- UM
 - Average MCAT
 - 32.6
 - GPA
 - 3.77
 - Science GPA 3.73
 - 150 Slots, about 7,000 applicants
 - Admissions documents submitted by August 1st
- UF
 - Average MCAT
 - 31.75
 - GPA
 - 3.71
 - Application start date: June
- FSU
 - Average MCAT
 - 28
 - GPA
 - 3.7
- USF
 - No minimum GPA or MCAT requirements, USF uses holistic review of all applications
