

## Rubric for Overall Clerkship Grades – Year 3

Each student will receive a final grade of “Honors,” “High Satisfactory,” “Satisfactory,” “Unsatisfactory,” or “Incomplete” in Patient Care, Medical Knowledge, and an Overall Clerkship Grade in each clerkship. Each student will also receive a final clerkship narrative for each core clerkship, which will be included in the student’s MSPE, although for space constraints the narratives may be excerpted. The PCRS competencies of Knowledge for Practice, Patient Care, Interpersonal & Communication Skills, Professionalism, Practice-Based Learning & Improvement, and Personal & Professional Development will be considered in determining the final grades for all the core clerkships. Details of how the Patient Care, Medical Knowledge, and Overall Clerkship Grade will be determined for the Core Clerkships are described below.
