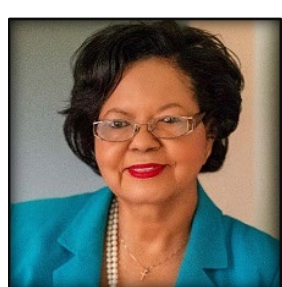
Artist
