




You can select to receive notifications when customers successfully complete purchases and/or have failed transactions.

These notifications may not be desired due to the **potentially** large volume of messages that could be generated.

Skip notifications for pending transactions	By checking this box, any notifications for transactions in a Pending state will not be sent. Pending transactions are created in International Funds Transfer (IFT) payments.		
Include transaction status	Indicates whether or not the transaction status should be included in the notification, typically only relevant to International Funds Transfer (IFT) payments. We recommend checking this box if you are using Flywire.		
Email Notifications	If you would like email notifications, enter the email addresses next to each category. Email addresses listed here will receive an email whenever a transaction is successful or fails, and using reports is advised over this option.		
	Separate multiple email addresses by commas. If you leave the field blank, you will not receive notifications for that category.
