Store Setup Navigation Overview

The Store Setup wizard allows you to design and edit an eMarket site with little effort and minimal technical knowledge.

The selected merchant code will display at the top of the column on the left-hand side of the page.

This column lists sections that may be completed as part of the Store Setup.

As you make changes in each of the sections and saves information, a check will appear in the sections' checkbox.

Store Setup Navigation Overview

- The sections do not need to be completed in the order they are listed.
- Click on any of the section names for access or click on the **CONTINUE** button at the bottom of each section's page to automatically save and access the next.
- The title bar at the top of the page will list the name of the current section.

Note: The sections that appear depend upon the operator's allowable activities.



Store Setup Navigation Overview

- A site does not need to be designed in one sitting.
- The wizard lets you save your progress, make changes as needed and **preview** prior to implementing.
- To view what customers will see, click on the **PREVIEW** button included within each of the sections.

Warning: If you are in preview mode and complete a transaction, it will be a real transaction. If just testing, you may need to void/reverse that transaction before performing any End-of-Day procedures.



Store Setup Navigation Overview

At the bottom of each Store Setup page, you will typically see several buttons (as many as 6), which can help you navigate the setup pages.

These buttons are as follows:

- **Save:** Saves your progress on the current page.
- **Preview:** Opens a new window to preview your progress (see Version Controls and Previews for more information).

- **Restore Defaults:** This will restore the fields on your current page to the values in the @@DEFAULT store.
- **Back:** Moves back one page (without saving).
- **Continue:** Saves the current page and continues onto the next.
