Withdrawal Limits

Students are permitted a maximum of **two attempts** (including “W” and courses taken outside of FAU) at each of the pre-business foundation courses. Must earn “C” or better.



Florida Civic Literacy Requirement



To **declare major** within the College of Business, students must meet the Florida Civic Literacy statute by completing both a course and exam.
