
- The course is offered twice per semester (Full and Second Half terms).

Withdrawal Limits

Students are permitted a maximum of **two attempts** (including "W" and courses taken outside of FAU) at each of the pre-business foundation courses. Must earn "C" or better.



Florida Civic Literacy Requirement



To declare major within the College of Business, students must meet the Florida Civic Literacy statute by completing both a course and exam.
