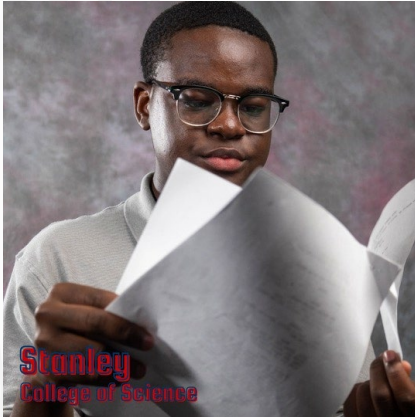

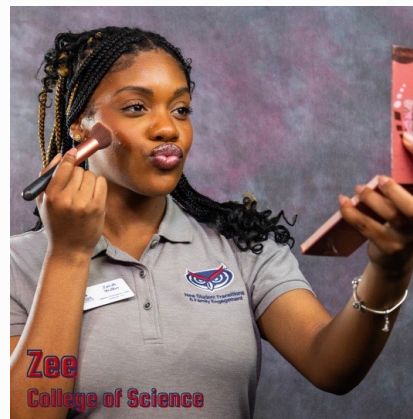

## *First-Year Connections*

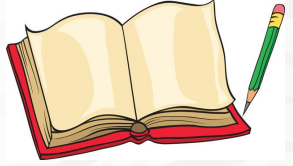
- Peer mentoring focus

# WHAT DOES MENTORSHIP LOOK LIKE?

- *Remember: Everyone's mentorship is different!*
- You will be matched with one mentor
- Your mentor is there for you in whatever capacity you need them (professional/academic/personal/etc.)
- How you want to structure your mentoring relationship is up to you and your mentor:
  - You both decide how often you want to meet (every week, every other week, once a month, etc.)
  - You both decide how you want to meet (in person, virtual, text, phone call, etc.)
  - What you discuss is also up to you
- All we ask is that you at least meet/talk twice in the semester





# REGISTRATION/MATCHING PROCESS

- *Mentor Collective is the main software used for mentoring*
  1. You'll sign up through Mentor Collective
  2. When you register you fill out basic information such as your name, college, major, etc.
  3. Matching survey-this is what we use to match you with a mentor
  4. Wait a couple of weeks to be matched (you will be notified when you are matched via a text and/or email from Mentor Collective)
