INTERNSHIPS HELP STUDENTS:

RESEARCH SHOWS THAT:

EARN COLLEGE CREDIT FOR YOUR INTERNSHIP!

How does the Professional Internship course work?

IDS 3949 is a 0-4 credit course that offers students the opportunity to gain "real-world" exposure and supervised experience related to their major, specific fields of study and/or career interests. Students must secure an internship prior to enrolling in the course. An Internship Specialist can assist you with your internship search.

More information about IDS 3949:

- The course is offered twice per semester (Full and Second Half terms).
- Students can register for the course multiple times.
- The course is fully online and graded as Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory.
- The course counts toward students' degree requirements as a free elective,

How to apply for financial aid

- To apply for financial aid, complete an online Application for Federal Student Aid (<u>FAFSA</u>). FAFSA.ed.gov
- Complete the FAFSA online beginning January 1 for the upcoming academic year to be eligible for most forms of aid.
 - The first FAU priority deadline is April 1, the second for the 2024-2025 school year.
 - All applications received after April 1 will be reviewed in order they are received.

Selecting year code

- Joining us for Summer? 2023-2024 FAFSA
- Joining us for Fall? 2024-2025 FAFSA
- The FAU priority deadline is April 1st for the 2024-2025 year.
- All applications received after that date will be reviewed in order of receipt.
- Apply online to save time and effort. When filling out the application, make sure to complete
 the planned housing code (on Step 6, Housing Plan, on your FAFSA form) with your appropriate
 housing status, since leaving this section blank could result in underfunding.

Apply for Scholarships with Scholarship Universe

- Apply for scholarships via FAU Financial Aid website http://www.fau.edu/finaid
- Scholarship applications open up end of January and usually have a limit of applicants


STEP 1: Access Financial Aid section on FAU Self-Service via MYFAU

After you have applied for financial aid, check often the status of your financial aid. You may have messages from the Office of Student Financial Aid in regards to missing information, offers and satisfactory academic progress. Check your FAU email.

Checking your Financial Aid Status

- 1. Sign into MYFAU with your FAU credentials.
- 2. Click/tap the "Money Matters!" tile.
- 3. Click/tap the "Your Financial Aid" tile to go directly to Financial Aid within FAU Self-Service







STEP 2: Accepting Offers within FAU SelfService

- Click/tap the "Financial Aid Status" tile
- From the Financial Aid Status screen, you will be able to view:
 - Student Requirements (missing documents)
 - Financial Aid Offer
 - Academic Progress

Using Financial aid to pay for Books:

Short Term Advance – up to \$750 in your direct deposit

Book Store Line of Credit – up to \$600 at the book store


