- Victim Services at Florida Atlantic is a resource available to all of Florida Atlantic's students, faculty, staff, and community members. Advocates are available to help, provide resources and navigate legal or university processes.
- Whether the incident occurred on or off campus, in the past, or recently, Victim Services is here to help.
- Victim Services can help with fraud, scams, discrimination, harassment, bullying, hazing, extortion, dating violence, domestic violence, physical assault, sexual assault, witnesses, threats, stalking, or being made uncomfortable by another person
- You do not have to submit an official report to speak to an advocate!

#### Respondent Services

- Provides guidance, resources, information, and referrals for students who have been accused of sexual misconduct violations of the Student Code of Conduct or the Anti-Discrimination and Anti-Harassment regulation
- Assists students with understanding their rights
- Aides students in navigating investigation and adjudication processes
