Our Fraternity and Sorority Life Community

- →27 social Greek-lettered organizations, divided into4 councils
- →Nearly 6% of FAU undergraduate students are members of fraternities and sororities → about 1,400 members
- →Chapter members completed more than **6,000** hours of community service in 2020
- →Chapters raised over \$130,000 for charitable organizations in the last year (2020) *alone*

Sorority and Fraternity

Greek familial organizations of sisters and/or brothers founded on social, philanthropic, scholarship, religious, cultural, and/or community service principles

Interest

A person seeking membership into a UGC or NPHC organization

Intake

The process of becoming a member in a UGC or NPHC organization

PNM

Potential New Member, one who is seeking membership into CPA or IFC

Primary Recruitment

Series of events held by each CPA and IFC to recruit and select new members

all-women's sororities

Cost and Requirements of IFC & CPA

No FAU credits needed to join (can join as a first-semester freshman)

Average GPA requirement: 2.75 (depends on the organization)

Dues are paid semesterly
first semester will be a bit higher
while a new member
(\$600-\$800 first semester and \$500-\$700
each semester after that)







United Greek Council (UGC)

culturally-based fraternities and sororities + one co-ed organization

- →Sigma Beta Rho Fraternity (∑BP)"SigRho"
- → Delta Kappa Delta Sorority, Inc. (ΔΚΔ) "DKD" *coming Fall 2021





National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC)

Also known as The Divine Nine, historically black fraternities and sororities

- →Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. (AΦA) "Alphas"
- → Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. (AKA) "AKA"
- →Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. (КАѰ) "Kappas"
- \rightarrow Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. ($\Omega\Psi\Phi$), "Omegas"
- \rightarrow Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. (ΔΣΘ) "Deltas"
- \rightarrow Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. (Φ B Σ) "Sigmas"
- →Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. (ZФB) "Zetas"
- →Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc. (ΣΓΡ) "SGRhos"





Cost and Requirements of UGC & NPHC

Some FAU credits needed to join (between 12-36 depending on the organization)

Average GPA requirement: 2.50+ (depends on the organization)

Dues are paid up front when you join, then annually after that (\$200 - \$2,000 depending on the organization)


