Wilkes Honors College Peer Mentor Program Survey AY 2020-2021 Data

During Fall 2020, Jupiter Campus Life in partnership with Wilkes Honors College launched the WHC Peer Mentoring Program. The program was crucial during the 2020 Covid 19 pandemic, connecting new students in a virtual environment.

A total of 252 students were invited to participate in the inaugural program

- 41 mentors and 4 leaders and 207 incoming Fall 2020 students
- The program had a 70.63% participation rate

To gain insight into student satisfaction with our new mentoring program, a survey was administered to Wilkes Honors College students in late Fall 2020. There were 60 respondents for this survey.

Some brief takeaways from the survey:

- Most respondents preferred to talk with their mentors in person or via video platform.
- Most respondents strongly agree that having a mentor helped them find resources to achieve their social needs.
- Most respondents strongly agree that having a mentor made them feel that people at the Wilkes Honors College care about them.
