ACCREDITATION ASSESSMENT TEAM INVITES PUBLIC TO COMMENT

On Sunday, April 26, 2026, Assessors from the International Association of Campus Law Enforcement Administrators (IACLEA) will commence examining all aspects of the Florida Atlantic Police Department's policy and procedures, management, operation, and support services, Chief Brammer announced today. The assessment will end on Tuesday, April 28, 2026.

Verification by the team that Florida Atlantic Police Department meets IACLEA's state-of-the-art standards is part of a voluntary process to gain accreditation – a highly prized recognition of campus public safety professional excellence, he said.

The Florida Atlantic Police Department must comply with 200+ standards in order to achieve accredited status. Chief Brammer states "Accreditation is a coveted certification that validates our agency's professionalism and trust. It lets my team and the community know that we are transparent and maintain a prominent level of accountability".

The accreditation manager for Florida Atlantic Police Department is Kimberly Strong. She said the assessment team is composed of experienced campus law enforcement professionals from out-of-state. The assessors will review written materials, interview individuals, and inspect facilities where compliance can be witnessed. The assessors are Team Leader, Margaret "Peg" Gant, Assistant Director II/Accreditation Manager, University of North Texas Police Department and Denise Schulze, Accreditation Coordinator, Cornell University Police Department, Ithaca, New York. Once the assessors complete their review of the department, they will report back to IACLEA, which will then decide if the department is to be granted accredited status, stated Kimberly Strong.

Accreditation is for four years, during which the department must submit annual reports attesting to continued compliance with those standards under which it was initially accredited.
