Certifying faculty in ACUE's Effective Teaching Practice Framework is proven to propel students' success, increase retention of first-year students, and lower DFW rates.

Certificate in Effective Teaching Practice Framework

To obtain this certificate, you need to complete one of the two ACUE flagship pathways: Effective Teaching Practices <u>or</u> Effective Online Teaching Practices, which include four courses in their curricula.

Alternatively, you can choose to complete four separate courses or micros, which cover the essential topics:

- 1. Designing Learner-Centered Courses
- 2. Promoting Active Learning
- 3. Inspiring Inquiry and Preparing Lifelong Learners
- 4. Creating a Productive Learning Environment.

The certificate demonstrates knowledge of and skill in implementing teaching practices that promote student success. Certificate holders typically have invested at least 50 hours to meet course requirements.



Advanced Certificate in Effective Teaching Practice Framework

To earn this certificate, you need to complete all courses, which is equivalent to completing Effective Teaching Practices <u>and</u> Effective Online Teaching Practices pathways.

These two pathways have one course in common: Designing Learner-Centered Courses, which will count towards both the Full and Advanced Certificates.

The Advanced Certificate demonstrates a deep commitment to student success. Certificate holders typically have invested at least 100 hours to meet course requirements.
