I. Honors Convocation Scholarship Criteria

Nominations are now being accepted for **three outstanding undergraduate students** from each college. Selected students will be recognized at this year's Honors Convocation, and a total of 24 students will receive awards across the following categories:

- Eight University Scholars (one per undergraduate college) \$1,000 each
- Hersker, Shaw, and Gosser Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi Scholarship Award \$2.500
- Stan and Renee Wimberly Scholar \$2,500
- Distinguished Student Award \$1,500
- University Club Merit Award \$3,000

Required Documentation

For each nominee, please submit the following materials as a **single PDF document**:

- 1. Cover Page (attached to this memo)
- 2. Nomination Letter from a faculty member, detailing the student's qualifications for the award.
- 3. A current transcript (an unofficial transcript from MyFAU is acceptable)
- 4. Evidence of Scholarship, Research, or Creative Activity limited to one project that best exemplifies the student's achievements beyond transcript
- 5. A one-page resume or curriculum vitae (Optional)

Eligibility

Awards will be based on academic excellence. Nominees must have completed at least 90 undergraduate semester credits by the end of the Fall 2025 semester (including 20 credits at FAU) and **must have an institutional GPA of 3.6 or higher**. A list of eligible students is attached for your convenience.

The **Distinguished Student Award** specifically honors a nominee who has significantly enhanced the learning environment through outstanding contributions, inspiration to others, or high achievement despite exceptional circumstances.

Submission Deadline

Once the college-level screening is complete, please submit all nominations and supporting documents as a **single PDF** <u>HERE</u> (sign-in required for access within Florida Atlantic University) by **January 30, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.**
