Community Partnership and Curricular Service-Learning

Florida Atlantic University and Palm Beach Community College will be hosting a workshop titled Bridging our Colleges and Community through Civic Engagement and Curricular Service-Learning.

Come and engage in workshops on Service-Learning and Community-Based Participatory Research. The workshops will introduce these teaching strategies to participants and will then take participants through curriculum integration activities that will include issues related to academic rigor, student motivation, assessment, as well as how these teaching strategies may be used to help with tenure and promotion. The faculty workshops will take place as a part of a broader Community Partnership Workshop and will provide faculty with various opportunities to connect with local community-serving organizations.

Service-Learning is generally defined as a teaching method that uses community involvement to apply theories or skills being taught in a course. Service-learning furthers the objectives of the academic course and addresses community needs as students participate in their service activities. Students are evaluated by how effectively they are able to connect and display course content to class assignments associated with the service project.

Community-based participatory research is a process that involves community members or recipients of interventions in all phases of the research process, including (1) identifying the issues of concern to the community; (2) developing assessment tools; (3) collecting, analyzing, and interpreting data; (4) determining how data can be used to inform actions to improve the community; (5) creating the research designs; (6) designing, implementing, and evaluating interventions; and (7) disseminating findings.

The workshop is hosted by Florida Campus Compact and FAU Volunteer Center and will take place on Friday, February 23rd in the Majestic Palm Room from 9 am to 12 pm (registration and breakfast will begin at 8:30am).
