	Step 1: Submit Online Application Form Submit your Online Application Form after discussing your interest with your school counselor.	Submitting the online application is the first step. You must complete all application steps to participate in the program

	You must activate your NETID prior to submitting your application materials.	In order to log in to MyFAU, you will need to look up your FAUNet ID (your username) if you do not already have it. To look up your FAU Net ID: o Go to https://myfau.fau.edu o Click "Activate your FAU Account" o Select "FAUNet ID Lookup Tool" o Fill out the information and follow the steps to obtain your FAUNet ID Once you have obtained your ID, click on "Home", and then select "Activate Your FAUNet ID". Fill out the information and follow the steps to activate your ID. After you log in to your MYFAU account, you will see a tile with your Z# and email, as well as a link to FAU Self-Service.

	Step 5: Complete Dual Enrollment Orientation The Dual Enrollment Orientation is completed online through Canvas. Completion is required for registration.	All new students who are accepted into the program will receive a Canvas invite for the orientation. Your Application Complete email will specify when the orientation will become available.
	Step 6: Obtain Prerequisite Overrides	We recommend reaching out to the department at least two weeks prior to registration. Additional information can be found in your Dual Enrollment Orientation
	Step 7: Check Your Holds Use MyFAU Self-Service to check your holds.	Two weeks prior to registration, check your holds and ensure there is nothing that will prevent you from registering!
	Step 8: Register For Classes Check our website to see when you can register!	Registration opens 2-3 weeks prior to when classes begin. Students register themselves through MyFAU Self-Service.
