## **CAPS AND GOWNS**

All graduates must wear full academic regalia to participate in the commencement ceremony. Graduates are required to wear FAU's customized regalia available exclusively through the FAU Bookstore. Graduates will not be allowed to participate in the ceremonies without FAU's customized regalia.

**Bachelor and Master:** You may purchase your cap and gown online. See below for pricing options. The deadline to place an online order is July 1<sup>st</sup>. After July 1<sup>st</sup>, caps and gowns will only be available through the FAU Bookstore on campus. To avoid paying additional late fees, graduates are encouraged to order their regalia online before July 1<sup>st</sup>. Contact the <u>FAU Bookstore</u> at (561) 297-3720 for more details.

**Doctoral:** You may rent or purchase doctoral regalia online. See below for pricing options. The deadline to place an online order is July 19<sup>th</sup>. ### **GRADUATE CHECK-IN/PROCESSION**

Graduates should report to the Live Oak Pavilion **1 hour** before the beginning of the ceremony. The Live Oak Pavilion is located across from Parking Garage 1 and can also be accessed through the Student Union. For further directions, please use the campus map.

The procession of graduates begins 20 minutes before your ceremony start time. To ensure you are able to walk in the procession we strongly advise you arrive 1 hour early. For example, if your ceremony is at 1:00pm, the procession of graduates will begin at 12:40pm. Please plan accordingly so you do not miss any part of your special day. Should you arrive after the procession has started, you will be seated directly in the auditorium with your fellow graduates.

#### **GUEST TICKETS/ SEATING**

- Seating in the Carole and Barry Kaye Performing Arts Auditorium is limited and admission to the Commencement Ceremony is by **ticket only** (graduates do not require a ticket).
- Only students who reply to this email by July 9<sup>th</sup> will be eligible to receive up to 4 guest tickets. Tickets will be emailed to their FAU email account between July 11<sup>th</sup> and July 17<sup>th</sup>.
- Doors to the auditorium open 1 hour ahead of the ceremony. Guests are strongly encouraged to
  arrive early to allow adequate time to park and pass through the security screening. Guests
  arriving 20 minutes before the ceremony will be delayed from entering the auditorium
  until the procession of graduates concludes.

#### **TRANSCRIPTS**

Degrees are certified and awarded approximately 1-week after final grades are due for the semester; therefore, it is recommended that you check your unofficial transcript for final grades and awarded degree status before ordering an <u>official transcript</u>. Alternatively, you may select the option of "After Degree" when ordering your official transcript if you must place your order before your degree has been awarded. The University must charge for all official transcripts and cannot waive fees for those ordered incorrectly. You may order an official transcript online through <u>MyFAU</u>. #### **DIPLOMAS**

Degrees are certified and awarded approximately 1-week after final grades are due for the semester.
