Graduates will not be allowed to participate in the ceremonies without Florida Atlantic's customized regalia.

Doctoral: The website to rent or purchase your doctoral regalia online is now available. See below for pricing options. The deadline to place an online order with standard shipping fees is July 5th. Any orders received between July 6th – July 18th will incur additional shipping fees. Any rental orders received two weeks prior to graduation will incur a \$25.00 late fee. GRADUATE CHECK-IN/PROCESSION

Graduates should report to the Live Oak Pavilion **1 hour** before the beginning of the ceremony. The Live Oak Pavilion is located across from Parking Garage 1 and can also be accessed through the Student Union. For further directions, please use the <u>campus map</u>.

The procession of graduates begins 20 minutes before your ceremony start time. To ensure you are able to walk in the procession we strongly advise you arrive 1 hour early. For example, if your ceremony is at 1:00pm, the procession of graduates will begin at 12:40pm. Please plan accordingly so

you do not miss any part of your special day. Should you arrive after the procession has started, you will be seated directly in the auditorium with your fellow graduates.

GUEST TICKETS

Seating in the Carole and Barry Kaye Performing Arts Auditorium is limited and admission to the Commencement Ceremony is by **ticket only** (graduates do not require a ticket).

Only students who reply to this email by July 7th will be eligible to receive up to 4 guest tickets. Tickets will be emailed to their FAU email account between July 9th and July 18th from no-reply@audienceview.com.

SEATING AND SECURITY

The procession of graduates will begin **20 minutes prior to the ceremony start time.** During this time, security lines will be temporarily halted, and guests will not be able to enter the Student Union until all graduates and members of the platform party have been seated. We strongly encourage guests to take this into consideration when planning their arrival time.

For the safety and security of all graduates and guests, mandatory security screening with metal detectors will occur upon entering the Student Union. All bags and personal belongings will be inspected, so we recommend only bringing essential items to the graduation ceremony. We suggest the use of clear plastic/vinyl bags to help speed the security checking process. The following items will not be permitted into the Student Union or auditorium: firearms, weapons of any kind, large bags, totes, backpacks, bullhorns or noisemakers, luggage, signs of any type, and other items deemed unsafe by Student Union management are prohibited. Plan your arrival to ensure adequate time to go through security.

PARKING

Due to ongoing construction, Parking Lot 16 and Parking Lot 18 will be closed. However, parking for the Summer 2024 commencement ceremonies will be available in Parking Garage 1 and other surrounding lots. TRANSCRIPTS

Degrees are certified and awarded approximately 1-week after final grades are due for the semester; therefore, it is recommended that you check your unofficial transcript for final grades and awarded degree status before ordering an <u>official transcript</u>. Alternatively, you may select the option of "After Degree" when ordering your official transcript if you must place your order before your degree has been awarded. The University must charge for all official transcripts and cannot waive fees for those ordered incorrectly. You may order an official transcript online through MyFAU. DIPLOMAS

Degrees are certified and awarded approximately 1-week after final grades are due for the semester. Graduates can expect to receive their diplomas in the mail approximately 6 to 8 weeks after the end of the term.
