F.S. 1002.42 Annual non-public school survey - This statute provides that the Department of Education is required to organize maintain and annually update a database of nonpublic educational institutions within the State. For the purpose of organizing, maintaining and updating that database, each nonpublic school must annually execute and file a database survey form on a date designated by the Department of Education.

F.S. 1003.43 General requirements for high school graduation - This statute sets forth the graduation requirements for public high schools. Students must complete a minimum of 24 academic credits in grades 9 through 12 for graduation.

IMPORTANT: Please read the information on this form. Your signature indicates that you have read and understand the eligibility criteria for the Home Education Dual Enrollment Program at Florida Atlantic University.

The Florida law that authorizes exemption of fees to Home Education students participating in Dual Enrollment mandates that Home Education Programs be in compliance with all requirements set forth in section 1007.27(4), 1007.271(10), and 1002.41, Florida Statutes. Eligible Home Education students may participate in Florida Atlantic University's Dual Enrollment Program.

Home Education students taking dual enrollment courses must enroll in academic courses that count toward the completion of a high school program. The student must meet all entry requirements including satisfactory test scores and prerequisites for any course. Furthermore, the student must make a grade of "C" or better in all dual enrollment courses to continue in the Dual Enrollment program.

Dual enrolled students may not enroll in courses that are less than 3 credits without a corresponding lab, courses graded pass/fail or satisfactory/unsatisfactory, directed independent study courses, study abroad courses, graduate level courses, courses for which prerequisites have not been met, and any courses in the College of Business other than ECO 2013 (Macroeconomics), ECO 2023 (Microeconomics), GEB 2011 (introduction to Business), and ISM 2000 (introduction Systems Fundamentals). The High School Subject Equivalency List is located online at www.fldoe.org/articulation/padf/DEList.pdf. Dual enrolled students can register for a maximum of 8 credits in the Spring and Fall and 4 credits in the Summer.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Students taking dual enrollment courses are subject to the rules and regulations of Florida Atlantic University as stated in the Catalog and Student Handbook.
- At an institution of higher education, students are exposed to a learning environment that promotes an open exchange of ideas. Course content is presented on an adult level where class discussions require a mature understanding of divergent viewpoints and the ability to think critically on controversial issues.
- Dual enrollment students who receive withdrawals and/or a failing grade may have difficulty in meeting future admission requirements at colleges and universities including financial aid and scholarship opportunities.
- Dual enrollment students who receive a grade of "C-" or lower in a course will not be allowed to enroll in future dual enrollment courses at Florida Atlantic University.
- Home education and private school students may dual enroll, but are financially responsible for all instructional materials, consumables, kits, and transportation.
