FAU Researcher Returns to Cuba



Brian Lapointe, Ph.D., and Lauren Herren, a biological scientist, of FAU's Harbor Branch Oceanographic Institute recently conducted water quality research at the Naval Station at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Lapointe and Herren are partnering with scientists at McMaster University and Dauphin Island Marine Lab on

the project to establish a water quality monitoring network that will be sampled monthly for one year. The researchers' goal is to determine levels of dissolved nutrients and chlorophyll *a* and analyze stable isotope of phytoplankton in the water column. The project is funded by the U.S. Navy, which also funded Lapointe's research trip to Cuba in 2011.
