Did you Know.....

FAU has a policy on who can serve as a Principal Investigator on a sponsored project. FAU's **Principal Investigator Eligibility Policy** has expanded over the years and now allows not only faculty (Full Professor, Associate Professor, and Assistant Professor) to serve as a PI, but also allows:

- Directors (Executive, Associate, and Assistant)
- Vice Presidents (Senior/Executive, Associate and Assistant)
- Librarians
- A.D. Henderson and FAU High Principals, Directors, and Professors
- Senior Research Fellows

• Full-time Instructors

The PI Eligibility Policy <u>does not</u> allow Affiliate Faculty, Visiting Faculty, and Adjunct Faculty to serve as PI. Individuals in these positions can be Co-PI or Co-I with an eligible individual as PI.
