Student Presentation Competition

Abstract submission deadline: November 6, 2018

Call for Presentations

A Student Presentation Competition will be held as part of GIS Day, Wednesday, November 14, 2018. The purpose of GIS Day is to showcase geographic information science technologies and research activities at FAU and beyond. Entrants present a research project that involves GIS or other geospatial technologies. The presentation must be based on primarily individual research, completed as an undergraduate or graduate student.

Guidelines

The competition format is a poster accompanied by a short (up to 8-minute) oral summary of the research problem, data, methods, and findings, followed by one-on-one or small group discussions at individual posters. All oral summaries will be given at the beginning of this competition before participants disperse to the poster boards around the room. Oral summaries must be given without the use of additional AV equipment (e.g., laptops and projectors). The competition will be from 9:00 to 11:30 am, 11/14 in SE 421, Boca Campus. Experts from business and academia will judge, taking entrants' academic level into account.

Awards

Awards \$\$\$ - prizes including one first place winner (\$100 equivalent gift) and two second place winners (\$50 equivalent gift)!

Eligibility

The competition is open to students of FAU at any academic level and from any academic department.

How to Enter

Submit a concise abstract describing your project (250 words or less) by Tuesday, November 6, 2018. Abstracts (pdf or word format) can be submitted by email to Dr. Weibo Liu liuw@fau.edu. The subject line in Email is FAUGISDAY_Your Last Name (such as FAUGISDAY_Liu). Please include the following in your submission:

Poster Title; Name; Email; Department; Academic Level (Undergrad or Grad); Academic Major; Abstract.

A limited number of presenters will be selected based on the quality and appropriateness of abstracts. You will be notified of acceptance on or before Thursday, November 8th.
