

Pre-Medical Mission Trip

The Pre-Health Professions Program at FAU organizes a pre-medical mission trip for students once a year. In May, a maximum of 14 students are escorted by FAU personnel to Ocho Rios Jamaica for a hands-on and observational educational experience in medicine. Students will complete one community service day at Lime Hall Basic School. The rest of the time is spent in clinics in St. Ann's Bay and Ocho Rios, and at the St. Ann's Bay Hospital.

Students will be expected to participate in fundraising efforts to provide much needed supplies for the school and medical facilities visited.
