Change of Major/Minor Denial

Per the "Undergraduate Students and Timely Graduation" policy

Majors

Change of major will only be allowed if the student can meet all graduation requirements within no more than two additional semesters.

- =10 total semesters for students admitted as freshmen
- =6 semesters for AA transfers
- =6-10 semesters for non-AA transfers depending on the number of credits earned

Change of major can only be denied if it will cause the student to hit excess credit hours

Second Majors and Dual Degrees

Students may pursue a double major or dual degree only if they are able to meet all requirements within no more than two additional semesters of the anticipated graduation date.

- =10 total semesters for students admitted as freshmen
- =6 semesters for AA transfers
- =6-10 semesters for non-AA transfers depending on the number of credits earned

Minors

Students may take a minor only if the requirements for that minor can be completed without extending the anticipated graduation date.
