INSTRUCTIONS VIA EMAIL




We'll send you an email with instructions for your Zoom appointment and a survey link to complete beforehand, so you are all set for you session!

FINDING A STABLE ENVIRONMENT



Try your best to find a quiet space in your home wih a constant light source and minimal background movement to limit distractions during the session!

PROPER SET-UP




Have your infant seated in a high-chair or booster seat, and have yourself seated behind your baby and outside of their view when they are looking at the screen. Remember, keep your eyes closed when the videos are playing!

YOUR ROLE



Once you help set up the Zoom call and open the link to the YouTube playlist, you will return to your seat and keep your eyes closed until the experimenter tells you that the videos are over to avoid influencing how your infant looks at the videos.

YOUR BABY'S ROLE



Your baby will watch the videos in the YouTube playlist until all of them have been played and the experimenter asks you to stop sharing your screen. Your baby should remain seated and (hopefully) be looking at the screen the whole time.

CLOUD RECORDINGS



Once the study is over, a recording of the session will be automatically uploaded to the lab's Zoom Cloud and only be accessible to authorized research staff.
