## Speaker Laurence Miller, Ph.D.

Areas of application include personal injury and disability, family law, civil and criminal competencies, criminal penalties, juvenile justice, police psychology, the insanity defense, and the death penalty. Finally, applications of psychology to the wider aspects of civil rights and a just society will be highlighted.
