



## Faculty-led Study Abroad Program La Fortuna/San Jose, Costa Rica

Explore Costa Rica & study the production & allocation of resources with a focus on business & economic development. Evaluate the role of the international economy (through the operation of multinational corporations & the conduct of international trade & finance), & the importance of cultural differences in business development & practices.

**Program Start Date (check-in):** May 9, 2020

**Program End Date (check-out):** May 16, 2020

**Application Deadline:** February 23, 2020 or as space permits

**Eligibility:** Undergraduate (sophomores, juniors & seniors) graduate students with a 2.5/3.0 overall GPA or higher in good academic standing. Prerequisites: ECO 1013, ECO 2023, or ECO 3003. Must enroll in one course offering below to participate on the program.

**Program Fee Required:** \$2,195 for single occupancy accommodations. Double occupancy available to reduce program fee by \$250. Must find willing participant to share.

- \$300 Non-refundable Deposit Due: February 7, 2020
- Fee of \$1,835 Due: March 6, 2020
- \$60 cash payment due at pre-trip meeting: April 25, 2020

Note: Program fee does not include required \$200 administrative fee paid at time of application submission.

**Program Fee Includes:** Airfare, hotel accommodation, international medical insurance, site admission fees and local transportation, daily breakfast, 4 group meals, activities, tours & lectures

**Not Include:** FAU tuition for study abroad course(s) (in-state/out-of-state rates apply), \$200 administrative fee airfare, some meals, personal spending money
