



Eligibility: Undergraduate (sophomores, juniors & seniors) graduate students with a 2.5/3.0 overall GPA or higher in good academic standing. Prerequisites: ECO 2013, ECO 2023, or ECO 3003. Must enroll in one course offering below to participate on the program.

- \$60 cash payment due at pre-trip meeting: April 25, 2020
