*300 field internship hours required as part of this course (about 16 to 20 hours per week). Eight of these hours are required to be during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, 8am to 5pm. A limited number of placements offer weekend and evening hours for the balance, but there is no guarantee that this will be available.
