STEPS TO APPLY *

- 1. COMPLETE AND SUBMIT** the online application at apply.fau.edu and pay the non-refundable **\$30** application fee.
- 2. REQUEST** official post-secondary transcript(s) for all institutions attended to be sent to FAU.
- 3. SUBMIT** official AP/IB/CLEP/AICE scores - and official SAT/ACT test scores and high school transcripts if transferring with less than 30 earned credit hours.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

LOWER-LEVEL TRANSFERS (12-29 Post-Secondary Credits)

- Meet Freshman Requirements, including HS transcripts & SAT/ACT test scores.
- 2.25 transfer overall GPA.

MID-LEVEL TRANSFERS (30-59 Post-Secondary Credits)

- English Composition class and College Math with a 'C' or better (3 credits each).
- 2.25 transfer overall GPA.

UPPER-LEVEL TRANSFERS (60+ Post-Secondary Credits)

- 2.25 transfer overall GPA.
- 2.0 transfer GPA for students with an AA Degree from a FL state college.
- Some majors may require a higher GPA.

Complete the checklist items found in your Owldone portal (owldone.fau.edu). The faster you complete the checklist, the faster you are able to register for classes. Here are some important items:

- Register for Transfer Orientation (SOAR – Student, Orientation, Academics, and Resources).
- Schedule an appointment with your academic advisor.
- Upload your immunization documentation.
- Verify your Florida residency at owlres.fau.edu for tuition purposes.
