

SLS 1503: Learning Strategies and Human Development

Instructor Qualifications:

- A minimum of a Master's Degree
- An original, official transcript from the degree granting institution
- Completion of instructor orientation/training*
- Approval of the instructor's supervisor/chair
- Participation in ongoing instructor training (1-2x per semester)*
- Submission of an approved syllabus
- Satisfactory student evaluations for previous SLS 1503 instruction (if applicable)
- Full time employees of FAU preferred

*Since SLS 1503 is an interdisciplinary course and is designed to meet some specific educational goals, instructors will need to participate in orientation/training workshops prior to teaching the course. SLS 1503 has a common course syllabus, however, opportunities do exist for instructor innovation and creativity.

Requirements:

- 2-50 minute classes per week
- submission of syllabus to Liz Kennedy prior to beginning of classes
- completion of a Letter of Interest form
- completion of appropriate evaluation tools (i.e. SPOTS)
- all instructors will need to provide a resume or vitae

Compensation:

- \$1600 for those with Masters Degrees
- \$1800 for non-faculty members with Doctorate Degrees
- \$2000 for faculty members
