






Proposed Innovation Entrepreneurship Certificate.

- In such cases, receipt of both the graduate degree and certificate will be complementary because the certificate coursework will prepare the students for entrepreneurial endeavors normally beyond the scope of their graduate degree program.
- In cases where these courses cannot be taken as electives, they must be taken as additional courses.
- If students are in the Entrepreneurship track in the MBA and take some of the courses listed above to meet requirements of the Entrepreneurship track, they will need to substitute other graduate-level entrepreneurship courses. In this case, there will be no duplication of courses.

Rationale: These courses have all been approved previously, and they are regularly taught. Thus, no additional resources are needed. The certificate meets AACSB requirements because it uses only AACSB-acceptable courses (i.e., courses previously approved for our AACSB-accredited MBA program). Making this certificate available to graduate students outside of the MBA program is consistent with University goals of spreading entrepreneurship across curricula.
